## FAQs

### Who is eligible to win?

The scavenger hunt is open to legal residents of the fifty (50) United States and District of Columbia ages 18 and up. Unfortunately, due to complex international promotion laws we were not able to include our friends abroad in this scavenger hunt.

### How will I know where the bikes will be hidden?

On each Monday starting June 15<sup>th</sup>, we will post a video revealing the location for that week's bicycle on one of our social channels (i.e., Facebook, Twitter or Instagram). Later that week, we will post a second clue on TravelOregon.com and RideOregonRide.com revealing the trail on the Wonder where the bicycle is hidden. On Friday or Saturday of that week (depending on the Wonder), a physical clue may also be provided on the trail near where the bicycle is hidden.

### Can I sign up to receive hints by email if I'm not on social media?

Yes! Scroll to the bottom of the page at [traveloregon.com/7bikes7wonders](http://traveloregon.com/7bikes7wonders) to sign up to have each week's first clue sent directly to your inbox. Visit [TravelOregon.com/7bikes7wonders](http://TravelOregon.com/7bikes7wonders) or [RideOregonRide.com](http://RideOregonRide.com) to find out what trail the bike will be hidden on.

### When will the bikes be hidden?

We will let you know which day the bikes will be hidden in that week's clue as well as the trail that it will be hidden on. On that day, we'll hide the bike at sunrise. The bike must be found before sunset in order to be claimed.

*7/22/15: We're impressed by how eager everyone has been to look for these beautiful bikes! However, for safety reasons, please don't begin searching before sunrise due to potentially dangerous terrain. If you arrive at the bike before technical sunrise (which we'll indicate in our clues moving forward), a Travel Oregon representative will disqualify you from the search and you will not be eligible to win that week's bike.*

### How will I know if/when the bike has been found?

We will post a picture of each winner with the bicycle on social media as soon as someone finds it. We will do our best to post to social media immediately, but given the limited reception in some areas there may be a delay. Be sure to follow @TravelOregon on Twitter and Instagram and/or "Like" the Travel Oregon page on Facebook so you get the most up-to-date information about the scavenger hunt.

### If I win the bike, how do I get it home?

Transportation for the bike is up to the winner and will not be provided by Travel Oregon.

Do I need to pay any fees to participate?

Nope! You may need to pay a land use fee to visit some of the Wonders but there is no fee to participate in the scavenger hunt. Note, winners will be responsible for all federal, state and local taxes based on the value of the bike.

**What happens if two people find the bike at the same time?**

We will ask each person 10 questions about Oregon. Whoever gets the most right, wins the bike!

**Will we have photos of the actual bikes?**

**Are bikes going to be adjusted to fit the winners?**

The bikes are provided as-is, so any adjustments or additional parts that are needed to customize the fit are up to the winner.

**If I don't win, how can I purchase one of my own?**

Each of these bikes is one of a kind, but you can purchase the beautifully crafted bicycles made by our seven bike builders by contacting them directly.

**How will I know that I found the right bike? I don't want to steal someone's bike accidentally.**

A Travel Oregon representative will be with the bike. That person will collect the winner's signature on the necessary forms and snap the winner's photo with the bike.
